

Confused man flees after attempting hold-up

Halton Regional Police Service is looking for a man who attempted to rob Scotia Bank on Guelph St. Thursday afternoon.

Police report at 3:50 p.m. a man entered the bank, and handed a female teller a note demanding cash. No weapon was seen.

The teller told him she was unsure what the note meant, the man was confused and fled the bank on foot.

He is described as white, 5'10" to 6", 170 lbs, with 1.5 to 2" long, dark spiked hair.

He had a tanned complexion and was wearing large dark sunglasses and a dark blue wind suit.

Choi's Convenience Store on Main St., Georgetown was robbed by a man brandishing a knife twice Sunday afternoon. The man

got away with a small amount of cash.

A spokesperson for Halton Police said the first incident at 2:20 p.m. was not reported to police, but police were called after the second robbery at 5:10 p.m.

The spokesperson said, as a result of the response from citizens, and police, including the canine unit, a suspect was apprehended later that day and some of the money was recovered. No charges were laid.

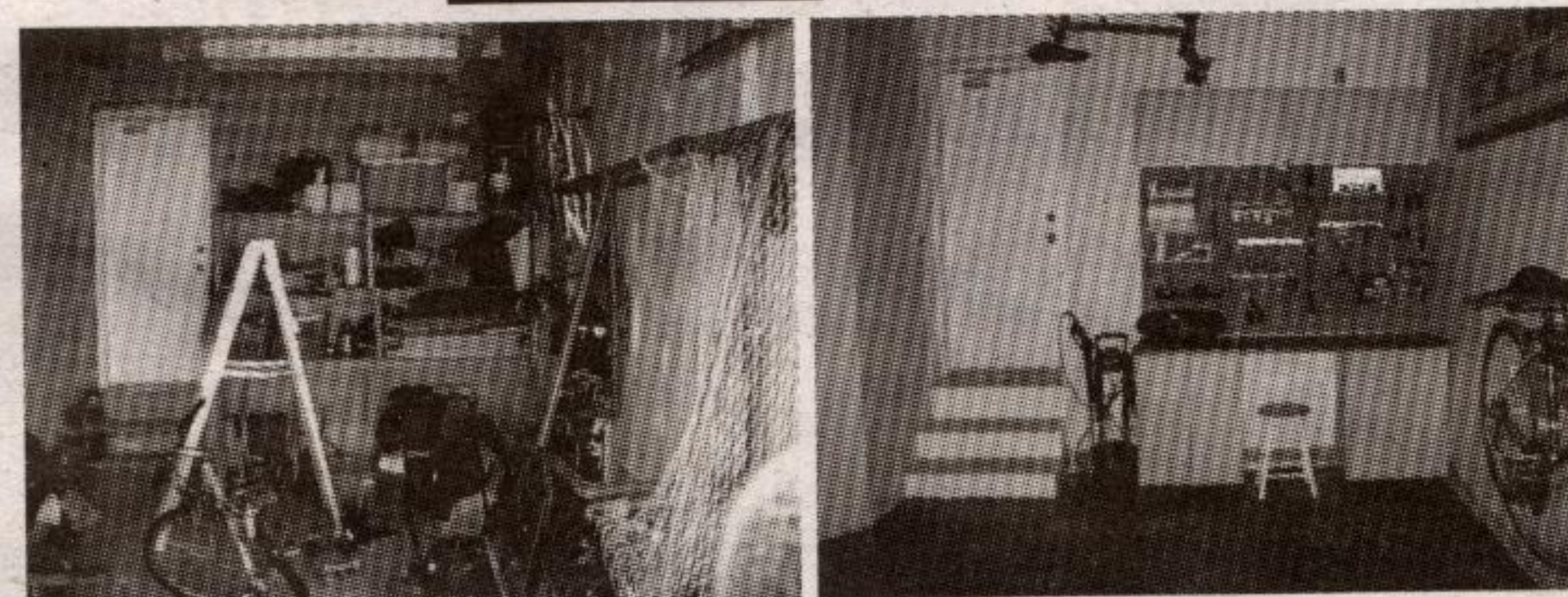
"Given the unusual circumstances of the events, prosecuting the offender would not be in the public interest or serve any useful purpose," said the spokesperson.
