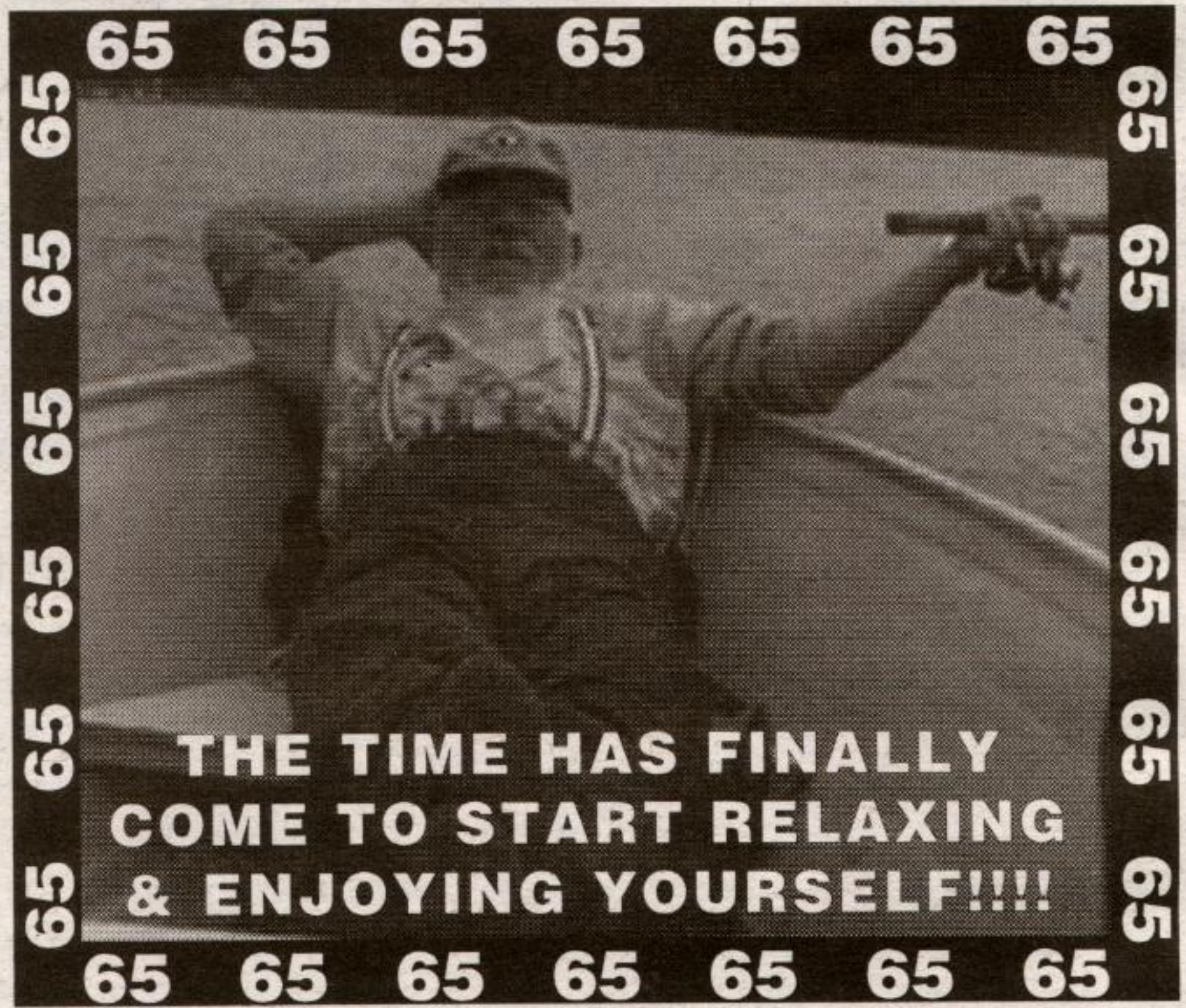
Minor Bantam
