Move For Health will be the theme of the open house, which is held every 18 months by the Cooperative Program Planning Committee (CPPC) of Halton Hills.

Active living programs, such as Ice Dreams, which encourages the development and use of new and existing outdoor rinks in Canada, will be promoted in the open house. Ice expert Karen Ford from the Town of Halton Hills will be on hand from 11 a.m. to noon to answer questions about building a backyard rink.

Also slated to be at the open house are Robert Little Public School teachers Marie Burland and Kristen Parker, both Quality Daily Fitness Leaders from the school who will demonstrate some of their routines.

Also on hand from 1 to 2 p.m. will be fitness expert Liz Masson from Feet in Motion, who will offer advice on choosing the right shoes for fitness activities.
