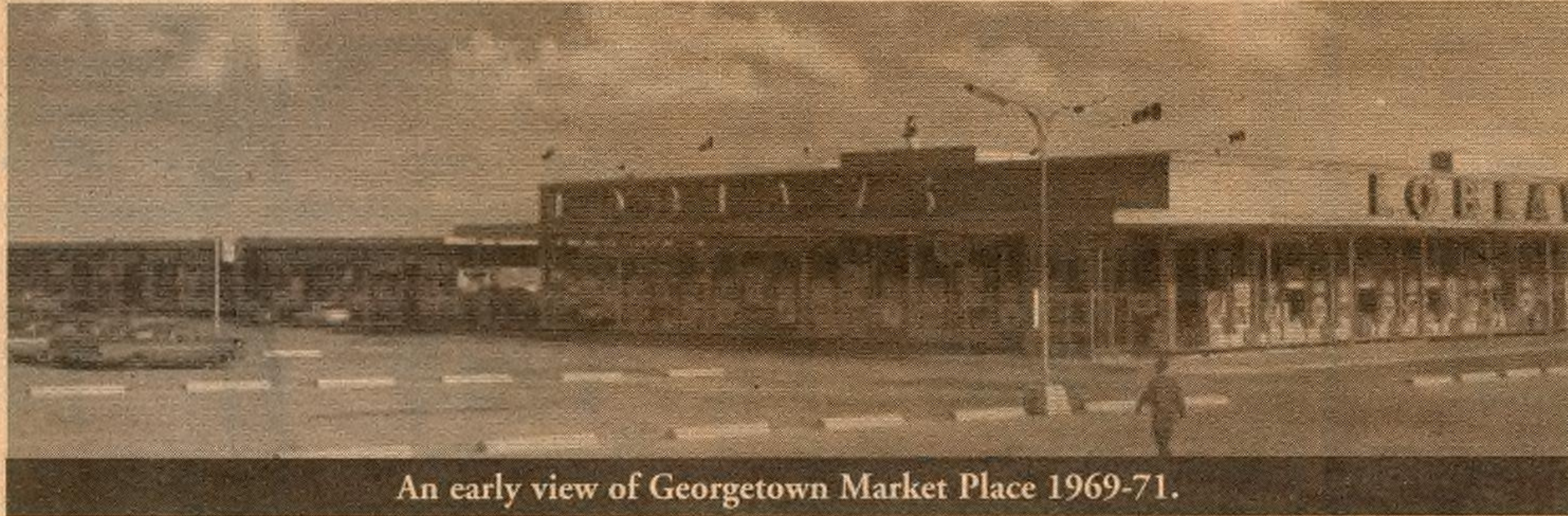
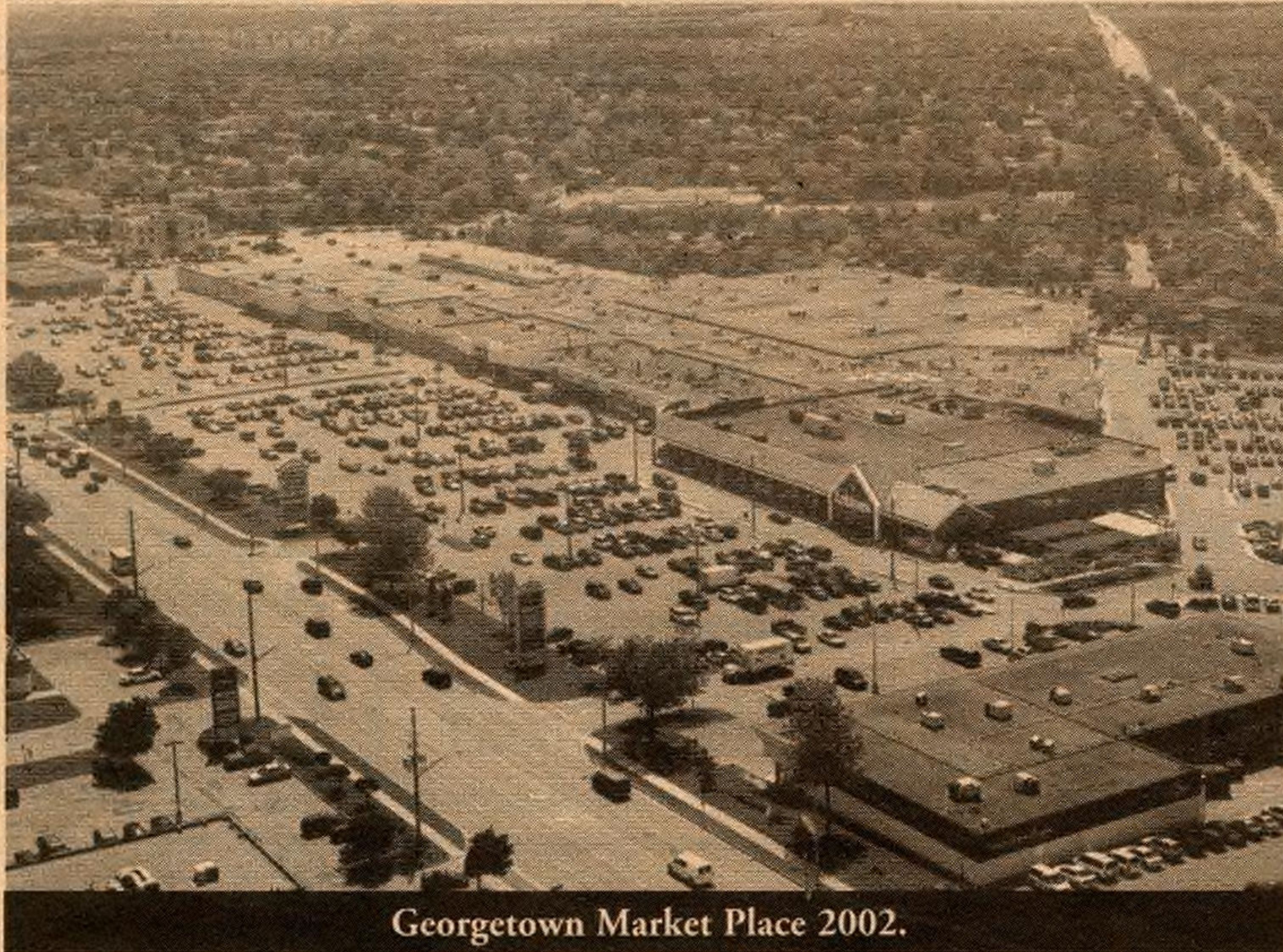


# GEORGETOWN MARKETPLACE

July 22nd, 1959 Delrex Plaza was built by Rex Heslop and opened its doors with seven stores. In 1971 the name was changed to Georgetown Market Place. At that time the town had a population of 12,000 to 14,000 and the landlord immediately constructed space for the first major department store Zellers, and also Shoppers Drug Mart. Some of the original tenants, who are still with us today are Delrex Variety (previously known as Delrex Smoke Shop), Supreme Hairstyling, CIBC, and Loblaw's.

In 1988 a separate building was constructed on the property, which housed Blockbuster Video and The Bank of Nova Scotia adjacent to hwy # 7. After several years of planning construction began to enlarge and enclose the Georgetown Market Place.

The new Mall was exciting news for everyone. The mall's goal was to make everyone comfortable by providing them with a clean & safe environment as well as to accommodate their shopping needs all under one roof. The mall quickly became the place to meet offering the community a place to shop, exercise, be entertained, informed and catch up on the local gossip.
