Young said he wants to make the clinic days as pleasant as possible with short waits, \* lucky draws and refreshments for patients. Other downtown businesses are supporting the clinics with coupons and other inducements for patients, many of whom are unfamiliar with downtown Georgetown.

"The clinics are a win-win for everyone," he said. "The public's health is served and Downtown Georgetown gets to see a lot of new faces."

The clinics are: tomorrow (Thursday), Wednesday Nov. 9, Tuesday Nov. 15 and Tuesday Nov. 22, 9:30 a.m. and 8 p.m. A member of the nursing staff is in the store weekdays and can usually accommodate most walk-in requests for flu shots outside

the clinic days. However, one is advised to call ahead to confirm a walk-in flu shot. Young's nursing team can also
