"This year's auction is a great way to find some really unique holiday gifts," said Walt Elliot, volunteer chair of the Auction Committee and

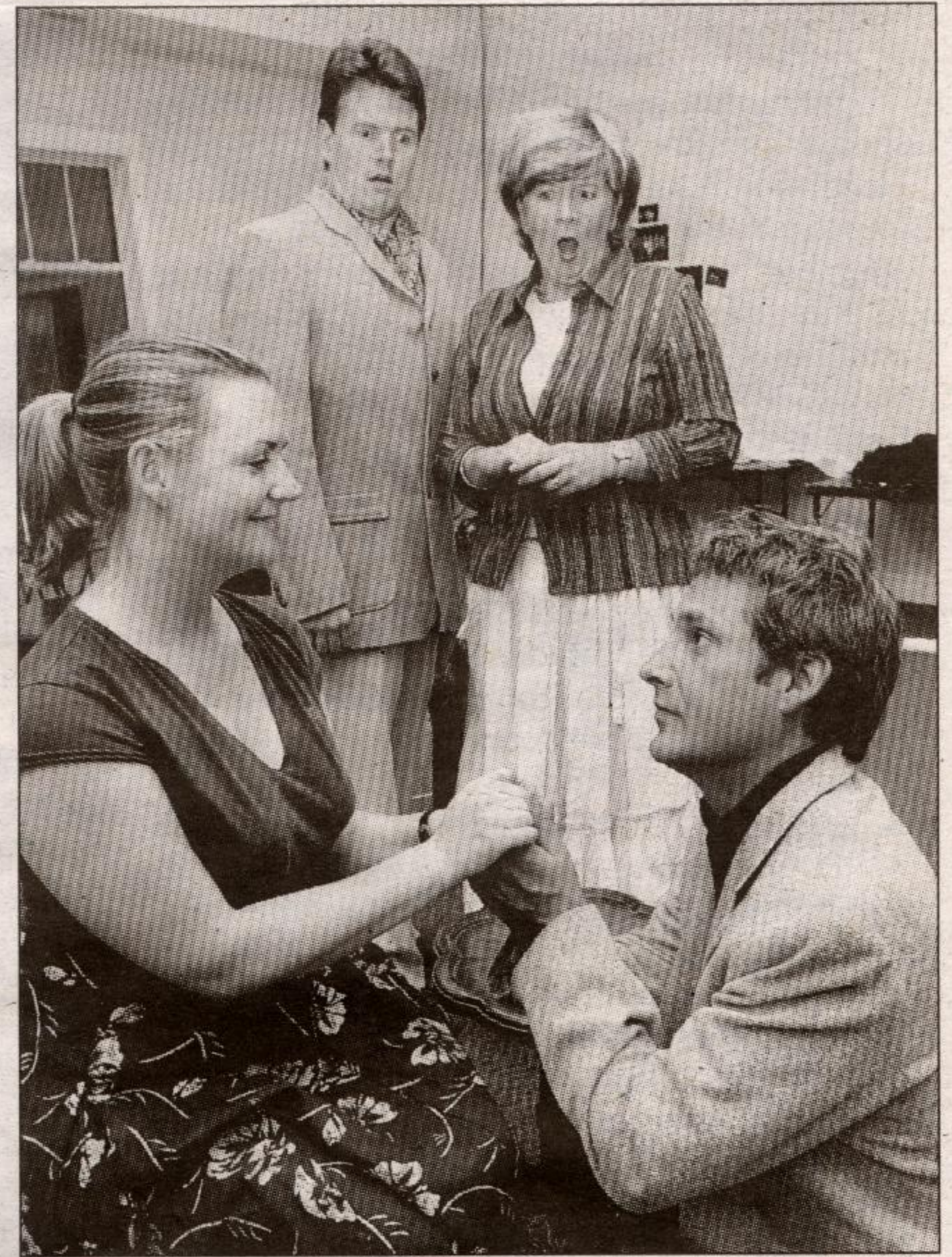
