The idea for the event originally came from Don Fendley, who runs the Georgetown Online web site,— a site for past and present Georgetown residents— from on-line chat.


Cotton said the event is expected

NOTICE OF A PUBLIC WORKSHOP

Draft Protocol for Establishing Telecommunication Towers and Related Facilities
Town of Halton Hills
File No. A12/Communication Towers

Town of Halton Hills staff will conduct a public workshop to present the "Draft Protocol for Establishing Telecommunication Towers and Related Facilities", which includes guidelines relating to site-location, design, and public consultation, for proposed telecommunication towers and related facilities throughout the Town of Halton Hills.

In general the protocols offers guidelines pertaining to the following:

- The exemption from a review process for co-locating towers, towers less than 16.6m in height, modifications of existing towers within 10% of the original height, and temporary towers;
- Provide a more expeditious review process for minor proposals including towers within industrial and employment areas and at least 150 metres away from residential uses, and for modifications of existing towers within 10%-25% of the original height; and,
- The requirement of a preliminary consultation meeting with staff, a comprehensive submission package, and a public consultation process through an open house information session for all non-exempt or non-minor proposals.

In addition, the draft protocol provides overall guidelines which will assist Town staff in identifying the appropriateness of proposals during the review process. Guidelines include the encouragement of co-location, landscaping, and the placement of towers away from residential and institutional uses, and lands with natural features.

A presentation will be provided at 7:00 P.M. followed by a question and answer period.



SECOND HAND SMOKE INCREASES EAR INFECTIONS IN CHILDREN

Ear infections are the Number One reason young children visit their doctors and take antibiotics. A new study finds many of those infections could be avoided if parents who smoke would make one important change.

A recent study in the archives of pediatric and adolescent medicine is giving parents another reason to quit. It finds exposure to cigarette smoke in the home increases children's risk of middle ear infections. The smoke inflames the tissues of the middle ear so that viruses and bacteria can invade more easily and cause infection.
