Home maintenance tips to get ready for the winter

Tf you're like most Canadians, your home is probably your I most important investment. It's also the place where your family spends a great deal of time. A regular schedule of seasonal maintenance can help you protect that investment for years to come, and keep your home and family healthy, safe and sound all year round.

Canada Mortgage and Housing Corporation (CMHC) has a short checklist of simple inspection and repairs you can carry out to help put a stop to the most common— and costly—problems before they can occur.

 Check and clean or replace your furnace filters on a monthly basis.

 Have your furnace or heating system serviced by a qualified service company (every two years for a gas furnace and every year for an oil furnace).

· Bleed air from the hot water radiators, and turn the gas furnace pilot light ON.

· Vacuum electric baseboard heaters to remove dust, remove the grilles on forced air systems and vacuum inside the ducts.

 If the heat recovery ventilator has been shut off for the summer, clean the filters and the core and pour water down the condensate drain to test it.

Have well water tested for quali-

Check the sump pump and line to

ensure proper operation and that there are no line obstructions or visible leaks

 If you have a septic tank, measure the sludge and scum to determine if needs to be emptied before spring Tanks should be pumped out at least every three years.

· Replace window screens wit storm windows and ensure all win dows, doors and skylights shut tightl including the door between you house and garage.

 Ensure the ground around you home slopes away from the foundation wall to prevent water from drainir into the basement.

· Clean leaves from eavestrough and downspouts to ensure prop drainage from the roof, and ched chimneys for nests or other obstru

 Cover the outside of air condition ers, and drain and store outdoor hose Close the valve to the outdoor ho connection and drain the spigot, unle it is frost proof.

 Winterize your landscaping l storing outdoor furniture, preparis gardens, and if necessary, protecting young trees or bushes for winter.






