The Town of Halton Hills will conduct a Public Meeting to examine and discuss proposed amendment applications to the Town of Halton Hills Official Plan and Zoning By-law 75-51 as amended, in conjunction with a plan of subdivision. The applications relate to a property municipally known as Part of Lots 14 & 15, Concession 11, Town of Halton Hills (Esquesing). The 43.2ha (106.7 acre) subject property is located on the west side of Winston Churchill Boulevard, south of 17 Side Road.

The proposed Official Plan Amendment would redesignate the subject lands from Rural Area to Rural Estate Residential Area. The proposed Zoning By-law Amendment would rezone the lands from a Rural (RU) Zone to a Residential Estate (RE) Zone. The subdivision application, processed under File 24T-89011/H by the Region of Halton, proposes the creation of 23 estate residential lots, open space blocks and stormwater management facility blocks.

Below is a map showing the location of the subject property to which the proposed Official Plan and Zoning By-law amendment would apply.

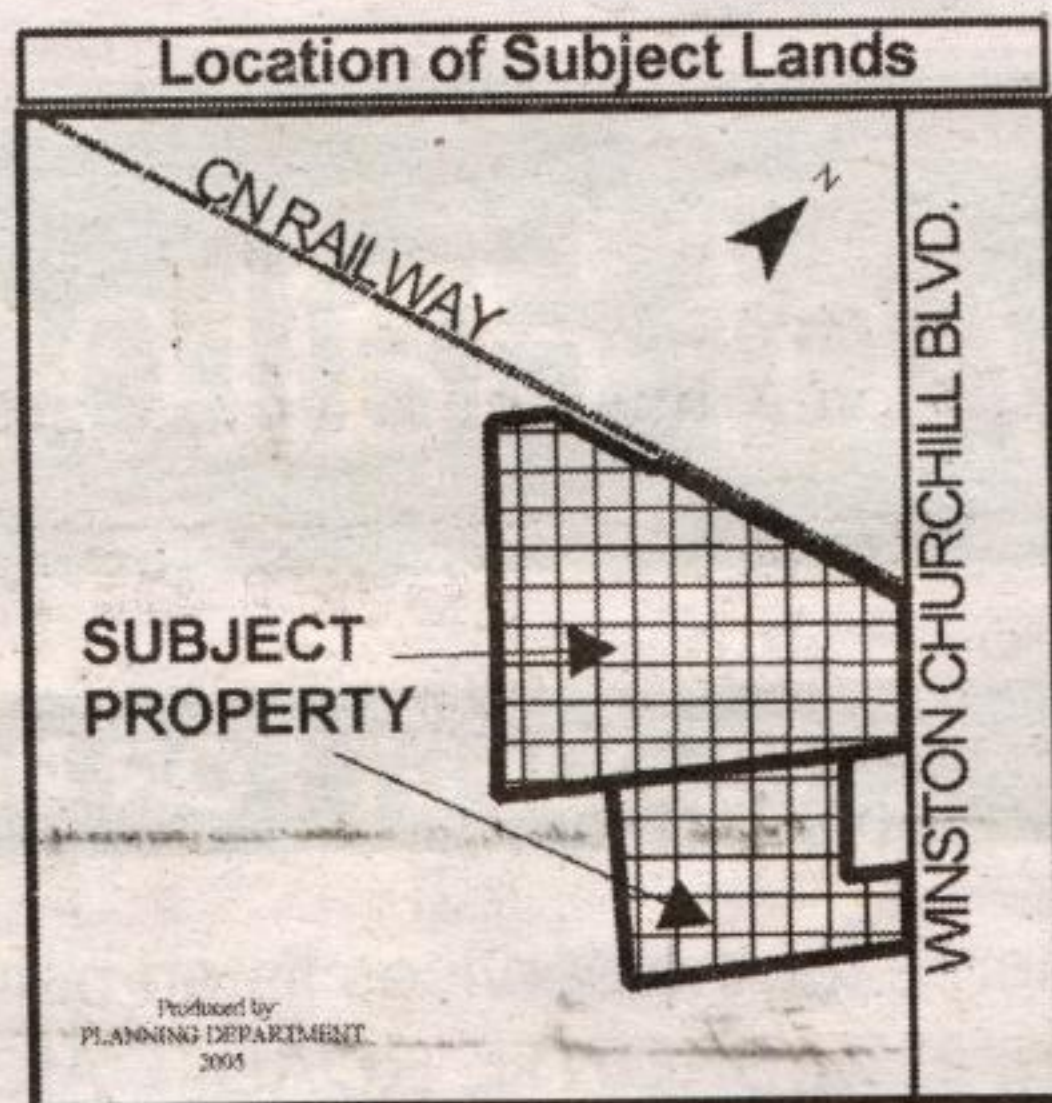

**Residential Accessory Buildings
and Structures Study
Proposed Zoning By-law Amendments**

Town of Halton Hills File No. D04/
Accessory Buildings in Halton Hills

Council for the Town of Halton Hills will conduct a Public Meeting to discuss proposed by-law amendments to the Acton, Esquesing, and Georgetown Zoning By-laws. The proposed Town initiated amendments provide standards throughout the Town of Halton Hills relating to detached accessory buildings and structures associated with residential uses only, excluding patios, pools, and decks.

The proposed amendments regulate the location of residential accessory buildings, including:

- Specific setbacks requirements, for residential accessory buildings and structures, including detached garages and carports, from the rear, side, and flank lot lines;
- Specific height requirements for flat-roofed and peaked-roofed detached garages and carports, and for all other residential accessory buildings and structures;
- Lot coverage and area requirements for all residential accessory buildings and structures; and,
- Specific height, setback, area, and lot coverage requirements for residential accessory buildings and structures within the Rural (RU) and Residential Estate (RE) Zones.

If you wish to be notified of the decision of the Town of Halton Hills in respect of the proposed Zoning By-law Amendment, you must make a written request to the Town of Halton Hills at 1 Halton Hills Drive, Halton Hills, Ontario L7G 5G2.

If a person or public body that files an appeal of a decision of the Town of Halton Hills in respect of the proposed Zoning By-law does not make oral submissions at a public meeting or make written submissions to the Town of Halton Hills before the Zoning By-law is adopted, the Ontario Municipal Board may dismiss all or part of the appeal.
