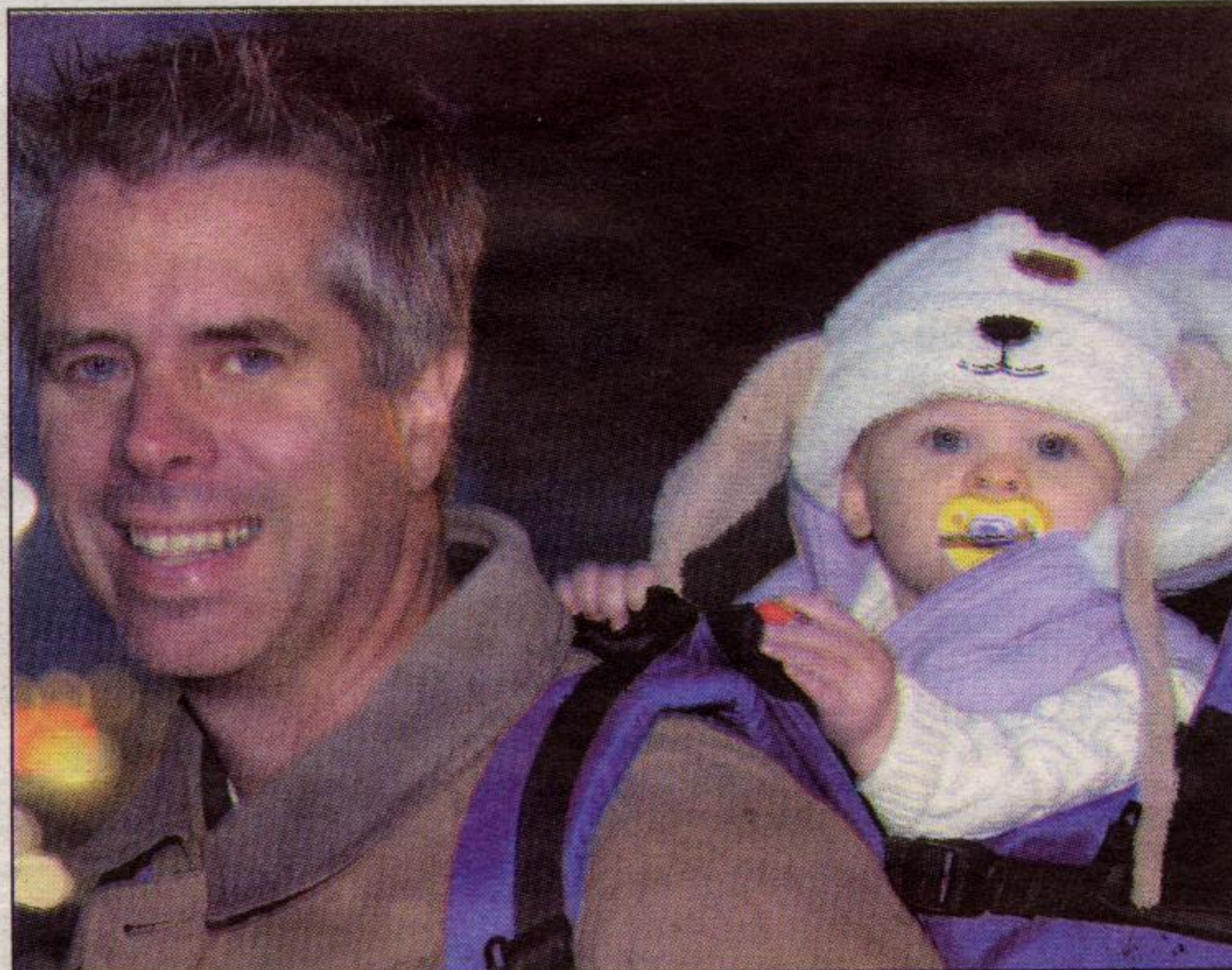


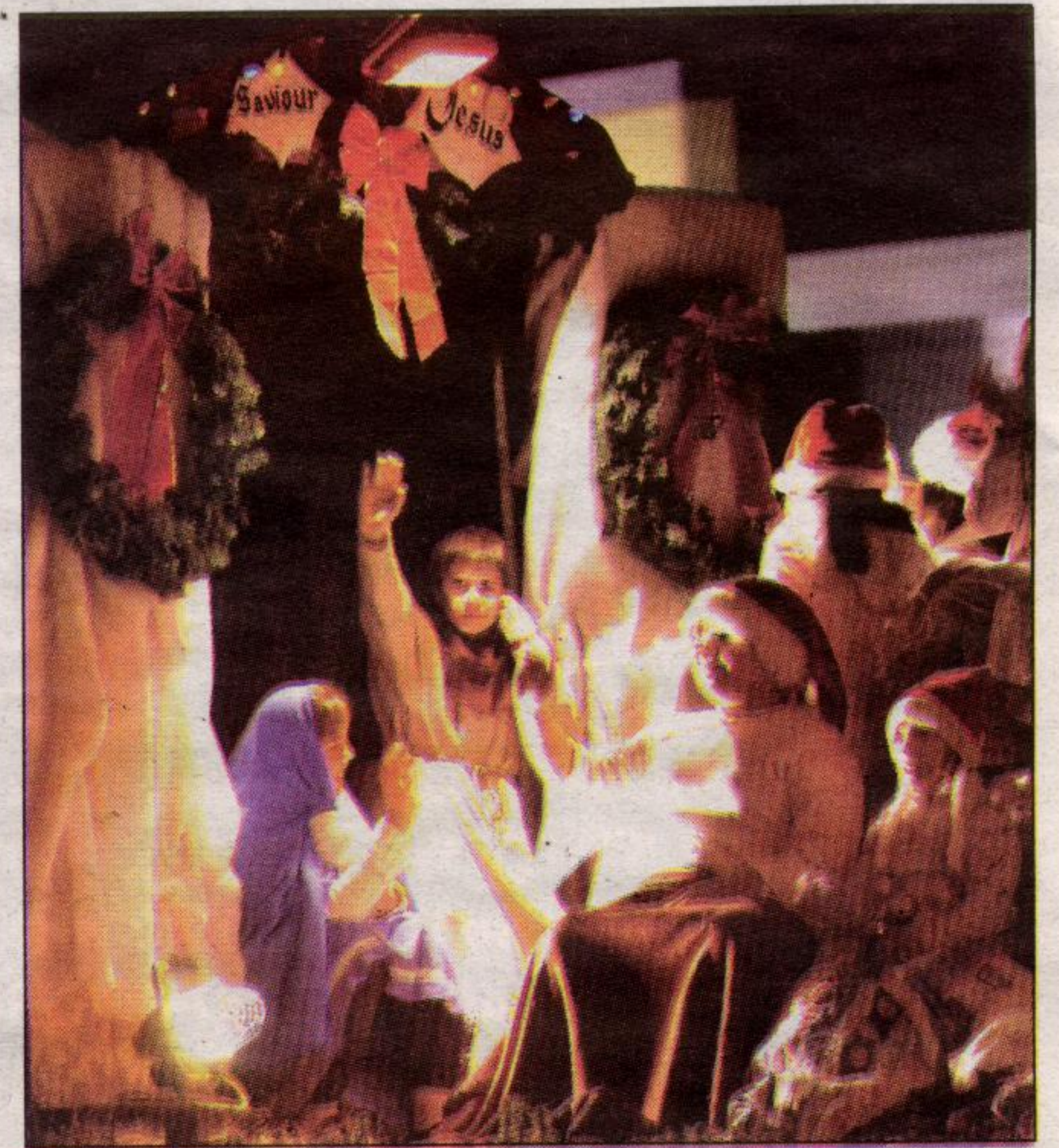
Georgetown Santa Parade glows
