To celebrate centennial Gazebo in plans for Women's Institute

The Norval Women's Institute will celebrate its centennial in 2006 with the construction of an interpretive gazebo at the Lucy Maud Montgomery Gardens in Norval Park.

The women's group will be aided in the venture by the Norval Community Association. The groups also hope to post pioneer cemetery signage at McNab and St. Paul's cemeteries recognizing Norval's early residents and publish a walking tour brochure listing points of local interest, historic homes, gardens and cemeteries and their contribution to Norval's history and character.

The two groups have applied to the Trillium Foundation for a grant to complete the work.

Recently Halton Hills council agreed to allow staff to enter a lease agreement—\$1 per year—with the Norval Community Association which allows the construction of the gazebo. This structure will include the original bell tower from the circa 1850 Norval School as well as display panels detailing the his-

tory of the area and its notable residents.

Council agreed to waive building permit fees—about \$1,000—for the gazebo, with the funding to come from the tax rate stabilization reserve.

The Town has entered similar agreements with the Georgetown Baseball Association and the Limehouse Kiln Society.
