## Local singer releases first CD at weekend event

**W**endi Hunter will release her first CD, *How Can I Keep From Singing?*, at Shepherd's Crook, 86 Main St. in Georgetown on Sunday, Nov. 27.

The 2 p.m. release party includes live music by Hunter and guests.

Eleven months in the making, *How Can I Keep From Singing?* is a sampling of the breadth and depth of Hunter's repertoire. The CD holds a mix of her own songs, traditional songs, and a few more contemporary songs—including a foot-stomping, old-time, kitchen party version of *Log Driver's Waltz*.

Hunter co-produced the CD with James Gordon at Pipe Street Studios in Guelph. Some songs are pure Hunter, highlighting her expressive voice with minimal instrumentation. For others, she is joined by a variety of talented musicians, embellishing her clear, simple sound with various combinations of guitar, fiddle, banjo, mandolin, harmonica, flute, clarinet, accordion and bass.

alone by herself, some by friends, enhance most of the tracks, and express the joys and sorrows found in the songs.

From the opening *Tired of Missing You*, written by Hunter, to the closing Quaker hymn, *How Can I Keep From Singing* there's music on this CD to

appeal to a variety of musical tastes.

Although Hunter has been performing since her teens, it took life-experience and maturity for her to gain the confidence to perform regularly. Now a lively and comfortable stage presence allows her to perform regularly in and around Halton Hills as part of a couple of folk bands and as a solo performer. Her favourite venue is at the annual Songs for Hope, a concert organized by her family to raised funds for research into childhood cancer.

Hunter began writing songs about six years ago. Her first song, which was short-listed by judges at the OCFE Songs from the Heart contest, is a lament about the long journey back to her late daughter.

Audience participation is always welcome at Hunter's performances. Her strongest belief is that music is a gift she has been given that must be shared and spread around—hopefully to spread some joy at the same time.
