Halton to get 34 more officers

Talton will have 34 new police officers on the streets thanks to recent-Ly announced provincial funding. The funding for Halton Regional Police is

part of the government's Safer Communities — 1,000 Officers Partnership Program, and was announced by Oakville MPP Kevin Flynn Friday.

"These new officers will patrol our streets, help prevent crime and help make our community safer," said Flynn. "The 1,000 new police officers being hired across the province are a concrete illustration of our commitment to the safety of Ontario communities."

The program is part of the Ontario government's plan to foster safer and stronger communities in Ontario. Half of new officers will be assigned to community policing duties such as street patrols, improved traffic enforcement and school visits.

"We're very pleased with the government's announcement today," said Halton Police

Chief Ean Algar. "Our service prides itself or our strong record in community safety, and our part in making Halton one of the safes communities in Canada. This initiative of the provincial government will allow us to continue our efforts in this very important area."

Algar said he was "very encouraged" by the fact that many of Halton's additional police officers will be assigned to community

policing activities. The provincial program will also allocate 500 officers to six priority areas identified by the government in its fight against crime in Ontario:

- guns and gangs
- youth crime
- organized crime, especially marijuana grow operations
- dangerous offenders
- domestic violence
- · protecting children from Internet luring and child pornography
