Of course, if you require immediate police assistance for an emergency please dial 911.

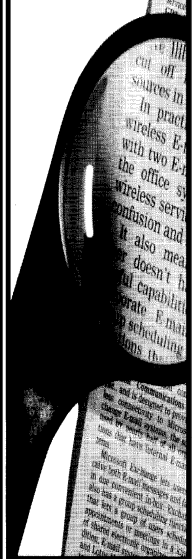

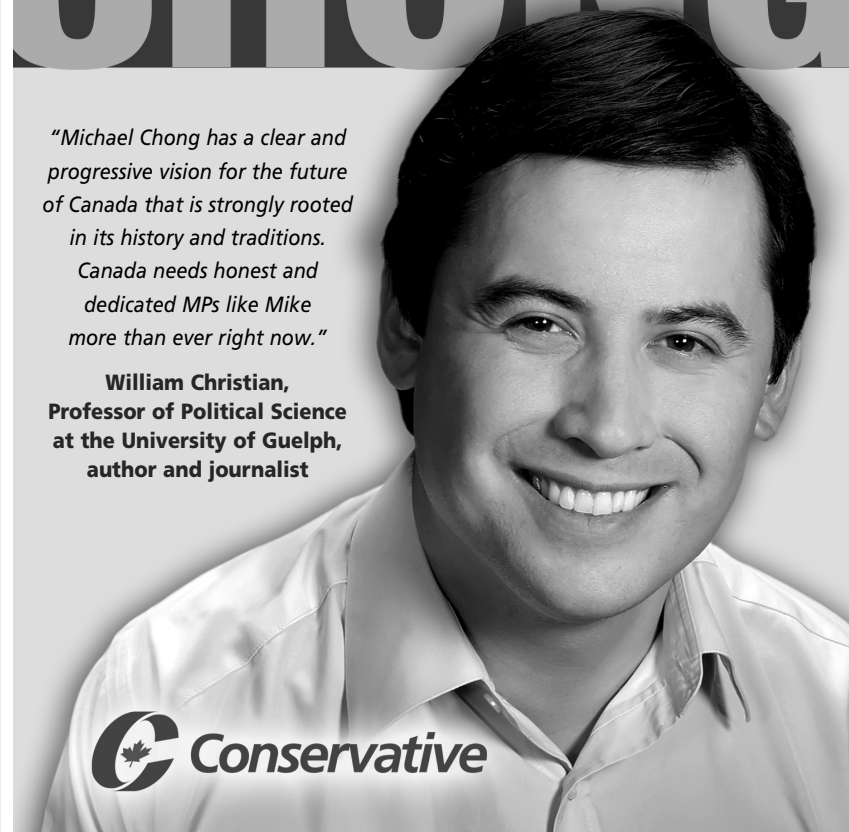
