Police report \$1,500 damage was caused to a Toyota when it was struck by a Volvo at approximately 12:15 p.m. Police located the vehicle and charged the driver.

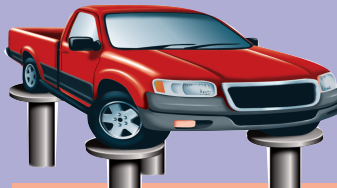
Charged is Steven Morley, 39, of Mill St.

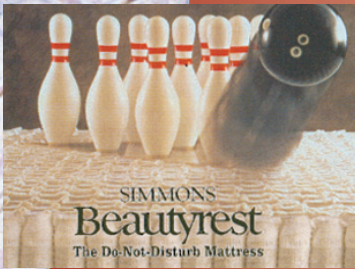
