Local hockey groups working to bring CBC show to town

As well, organizers are in the process of obtaining permits to close down Main St. in Georgetown on Sunday, March 5 at 9:30 a.m. for a massive road-hockey game. Residents are encouraged to wear red and white to help illuminate the spectator attendance.

Kraft Hockeyville, a collaboration between the NHL and the NHL Players' Association, will consist of seven one-hour episodes on Wednesday nights through the Stanley Cup playoffs, presenting stories from across Canada chronicling the country's obsession with hockey. The show's judges will narrow the field down to 25 communities, with viewers selecting which towns or cities advance to the next round at the end of each episode.

The season finale will air June 11, when a winner is declared out of the remaining five bids.

Organizers of the local bid will also draw on the town's storied hockey history, which includes Gordon Alcott's founding of the "Little NHL" here in 1936, in which youngsters had to sign contracts requiring that they would promise to be good citizens as well as hockey players.

Along with hosting the NHL exhibition contest, the winning community will receive \$25,000 for arena upgrades and \$10,000 for hockey equipment. For more information, visit the web site www.cbchockeyville.ca.
