## PROPOSED ENVIRONMENTAL & OPEN SPACE ZONING BY-LAW AMENDMENT

### Notice of Open House #2



The Town of Caledon is preparing an amendment to its Comprehensive Zoning By-law to implement its Official Plan Environmental and Open Space policies. These Official Plan policies were fully approved by the Ontario Municipal Board in 2003, and the preparation of the corresponding zoning by-law amendment has been underway since early 2004.

The Town held its first Public Open House on this project on June 20, 2005. At that time, preliminary draft mapping of proposed environmental and open space zones was presented, and information was provided regarding the potential contents of the zoning by-law amendment. Residents and stakeholders were invited to submit comments, and were given the opportunity to request site/property visits if there were concerns with the mapping. Since the June 2005 Open House, the Town of Caledon – with the assistance of staff from the Region of Peel and the Conservation Authorities – has continued to refine the draft environmental mapping and conducted property visits throughout the fall of 2005. Work on the draft by-law has also continued.

The purpose of Open House #2 on March 27, 2006 is to display the results of the environmental mapping refinements completed over the past nine months, and to provide additional information on the potential contents of the draft zoning by-law amendment and the effects this may have on certain lands. Information will also be presented regarding related amendments to the Caledon Official Plan that are also being considered. The Open House format means there will be no formal presentation – interested parties may drop in any time between 6:00 pm and 9:00 pm.

The map (at right) identifies the general geographic area within Caledon that contains environmental features that may be affected by this zoning by-law amendment. This general geographic area includes all lands in Caledon outside of the Oak Ridges Moraine Conservation Plan Area and the Niagara Escarpment Plan Area. Also included are the settlement areas of Terra Cotta, Cheltenham, Inglewood and Mono Mills.

The Town of Caledon is aiming to complete this project before the summer of 2006 and this second Public Open House is a crucial opportunity for landowners and other interested parties to provide input to the process.

The environmental and open space by-law amendment currently being prepared by the Town of Caledon will protect environmental features by changing the zoning on certain identified lands and regulating development and land uses on such lands. If you feel your property may be affected or are otherwise interested in this process, we would strongly encourage you to attend the March 27, 2006 Open House, or contact the Town of Caledon Planning & Development Department at x.4225.


*NOTE: Some landowners may be aware of another process that is being carried out by the Conservation Authorities regarding the establishment of new "Generic Regulation" limits. The Generic Regulation process is separate and distinct from the Caledon environmental and open space zoning by-law amendment, and is required by Provincial regulation. For further information on the Generic Regulation process, interested parties should contact either the Toronto and Region Conservation Authority, or Credit Valley Conservation, as applicable.*
