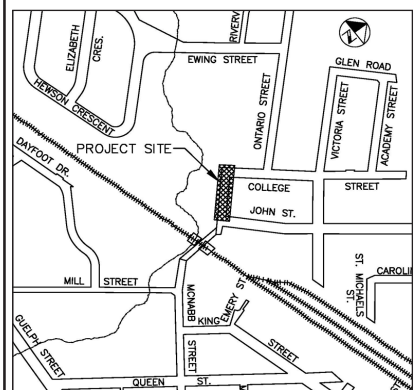
## CONSTRUCTION AND ROAD CLOSURE NOTICE

College Street will be closed to through traffic from Ontario Street to John Street to facilitate the installation of Armour Stone retaining walls. Access to residential driveways within the road closure limits will be maintained during the work.

The closure is expected to begin in **mid May 2006**, with reopening scheduled for **late June 2006**.

The work will include excavation, construction of armour stone retaining walls, gravel placement and landscaping, as required.
