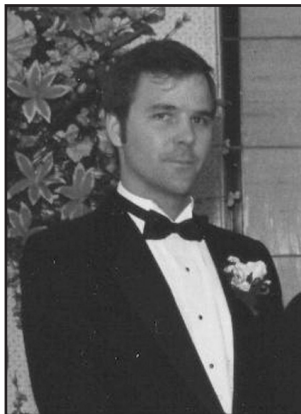
BOYD, Marjorie May Irene
