The Ministry of Transportation (MTO) has issued a Request for Proposals (RFP) inviting prospective applicants to submit proposals/business plans to operate Driver & Vehicle Licence Issuing Offices located in Cambridge, Georgetown/Brampton, Malton, Windsor and Pembroke/Petawawa, Ontario. The RFP was issued on April 5, 2006, and submissions must be received by May 26, 2006, by 11:00 a.m. Daylight Savings Time (DST).

A Driver and Vehicle Licence Issuing Office is an independently operated office, and provides licensing products and services on behalf of the Ministry of Transportation, such as driver's licence renewals and vehicle validation renewals.
