Speed limits there for a reason

Driving 101, part three. Speed. Big, reflective, white signs with 40, 50, 60, 70, or 80 in big black numbers on them.

When you are out driving and you come across one of these signs, the big black number on it indicates the 'limit' of speed that you are allowed to travel at while on that road. You can drive slower, but not faster than the limit.

Speed limits are determined by experts who consider volume and traffic studies, geography of the roads and intersecting roads, road surface, types of vehicles using the road, speeding complaints and accident records. The posted speed limits are designed for the safe driving of the average passenger vehicle on clear and dry roads. Drive slower in bad weather, at night, in construction zones, and when you are passing a stopped emergency vehicle.

If no speed limit is posted you must drive at or below 50 km/h.
