Stroke victim to stage 28-kilometre 'Power Walk'

"Anything is possible if you put your mind to it," says Lauren Boyce of Georgetown.

The 23-year-old, who is partially paralyzed from a massive stroke she suffered as a child, will be living up to those words Saturday when she walks 28 km to raise funds for Erinoak Children's Treatment Centre and awareness

about people with disabilities. She calls the event the "Stroke of Power Walk."

Boyce will walk from the Town of Halton Hills Civic Centre to the Erinoak Treatment Centre in Mississauga, which provides rehabilitation and support services for children and young adults from Halton and Peel with physical,
