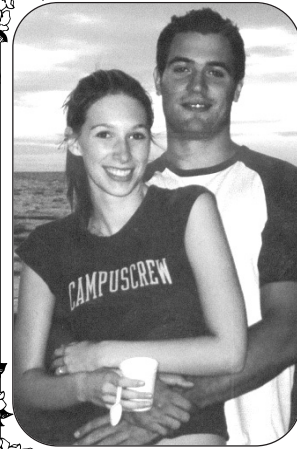

# On May 31<sup>st</sup>, we'll all be able to breathe a little easier

**Smoking is the No. 1 preventable cause of death in Ontario today.**

The Smoke-Free Ontario Act, which comes into force on May 31<sup>st</sup>, is part of a broad effort to improve public health by reducing Ontarians' exposure to and use of tobacco products.

The legislation bans smoking in all enclosed workplaces and enclosed public places to protect workers from second-hand smoke.

The legislation also strengthens laws on tobacco sales to minors and restricts the display of tobacco products in retail outlets.

If you smoke, now is a good time to consider quitting. For help and a plan to quit, call Smokers' Helpline at 1-877-513-5333.
