

CPI launches major expansion





Ontario Regulation 162/06
Development, Interference with Wetlands
and Alterations to Shorelines and
Watercourses Regulation

Effective May, 2006 Ontario Regulation 162/06 (under 97/04)
- Development, Interference with Wetlands and Alterations to
Shorelines and Watercourses - passed Provincial approval
and is in effect. The main objective of Ontario Regulation
162/06 is to ensure public safety with regards to natural hazards
through issuance of permits for works within or in proximity
to lakes, rivers, streams or wetlands, as may be required.

If you are planning to do any work, such as building, construction, changing the existing grade, adding material or removing material in regulated areas, you may need a permit from Conservation Halton.
