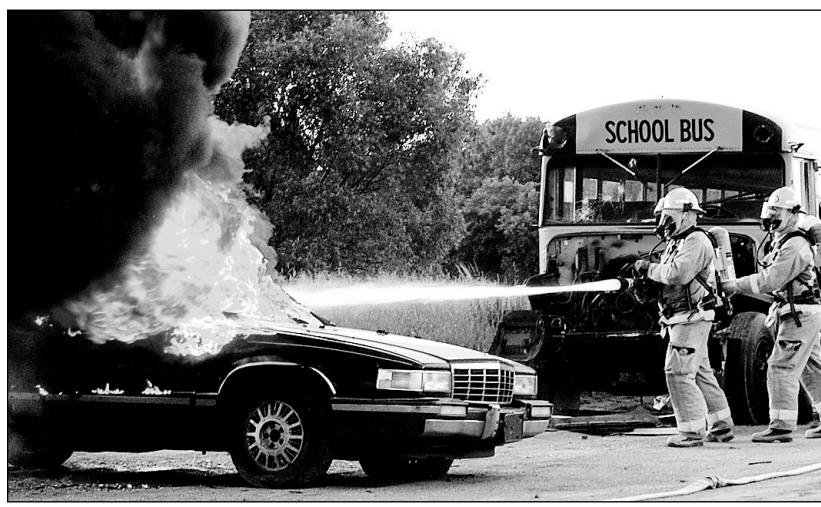

## Firefighter recruitment drive nears end

Halton Hills Fire Protection and Prevention Services are looking for more firefighters.

Anyone wishing to place an application for Halton Hills Fire Protection and Prevention Services can pick up an application at either Acton or Georgetown Fire Stations, at the Halton Hills Fire Protection and Prevention Services' Information Centre at the Georgetown Market Place or on-line at the Town's website at [www.haltonhills.ca](http://www.haltonhills.ca)

A recruitment drive has been ongoing and time is running out for prospective firefighters to get their applications in before the Thursday, June 29 deadline.

The applications can be dropped off at the same locations but must be handed in by the June 29 deadline.

Part-time firefighters with the Halton Hills Fire Protection and Prevention Service face new and challenging situations unlike any other job. They not only fight fires, but also perform rescues, administer first aid, deal with hazardous materials, protect property and are often instrumental in saving lives.

## Environment Day planned for works yard tomorrow

To be eligible for consideration as a part-time firefighter with the Halton Hills Fire Services applicants must meet a number of requirements.

Halton Region hosts Environment Day at the Town of Halton Hills' public works yard on Trafalgar Rd. tomorrow (Saturday) 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

- They must live within 5 km (3 miles) of the station to which they would be assigned. As time is critical in responding to emergency incidents, it's not considered feasible to have firefighters living beyond that distance. Those living less than 3 km (2 miles) from the station will be given preferential consideration.

Residents will be able to properly dispose of household hazardous wastes, tires (up to eight passenger vehicle tires) and electronic components free of charge.

- Applicants must hold a valid Ontario Driver's Licence, have a good driving record and be prepared to produce a statement of their driving record.

The Salvation Army will also be on site accepting reusable items.

- They must also have a Grade 12 diploma or the education equivalent and be prepared to produce documentation.

Blue boxes will be made available to residents free of charge and composters will be sold at a subsidized price of \$15 including tax.

- They must understand and be able to communicate clearly in English both oral and written.

As well, a Pesticide Exchange program will also be run.

- All applicants must be in good health and be capable of handling intense sustained physical effort.

**PAYMENT OF TAXES**

**WHERE?**

- Finance Department, Civic Centre (8:30-4:30 Monday to Friday), or
- Any branch of the Royal Bank located within the Town of Halton Hills (may be subject to a service charge)
- Payments may be left at the Halton Hills Hydro Office (no receipts issued)

**AFTER HOURS?**

- Royal Bank branches during scheduled hours of service
- Drop Box located next to main entrance of Civic Centre available 24 hours

**HOW?**

- a) By CHEQUE or CASH
- b) POST-DATED cheques are acceptable and will ensure that instalment dates are not missed
- c) INTERAC - in person at the Civic Centre
- d) By TELEPHONE: Check with your bank for further information.
- e) PRE-AUTHORIZED PAYMENT PLAN: For details please call the Tax Department at 905-873-2601, ext. 2930.

**LATE PAYMENTS?**

- A late payment charge of 1-1/4 per cent per month will be charged on the first day of each calendar month until taxes are paid.

**NO TAX BILL?**

- Bills were mailed June 7, 2006. Failure to receive a Tax Bill does not excuse the Owner from responsibility for payment, nor relieve him/her from liability for late payment charges. Please contact the Finance Department if you did not receive yours.

**NEW PROPERTIES?**

- Newly built properties are likely to have tax bills related to their land value assessment only until full assessment is applied and supplementary taxes are billed. Owners are responsible for taxes billed and should make provisions for the future billing of supplementary taxes.

**SENIOR'S TAX GRANT?**

- To qualify for the Senior's Tax Grant applicants must be 65 years of age, own and occupy property in the Town of Halton Hills for one year and be in receipt of the Guaranteed Income Supplement. Applications are available from the Tax Department and will automatically be mailed to those who qualified last year.


