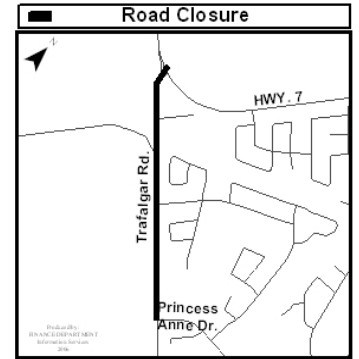




ROAD CLOSURE NOTICE

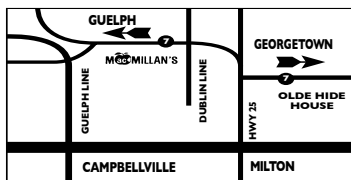
