We would like to thank the doctor and nurses at Georgetown Hospital, the paramedics that transferred Wesley to Sick Kids, the staff at Sick Kids, but we would really like to thank Mitchell and Jason, not only for being Wesley's friends but for how they responded in such a bad situation.
