

For the second time in just over two weeks Halton Hills was buffeted by a powerful storm that knocked down trees and kept town and hydro crews busy throughout the night.

Environment Canada had issued a tornado watch warning for Halton Hills and many surrounding areas Wednesday afternoon but the nearest report of a tornado touching down was in Guelph.


Acton area resident Kim Kirk of Hwy. 25 was shocked to find a 60 ft. maple tree across her driveway after the storm Wednesday night.

"The roots were lifted right out of the ground," said Kirk.

All that's left in the ground is a gaping hole.

The strong winds also tossed her screen gazebo about 100 ft. across her front lawn and "bent it like a pretzel," she said.
