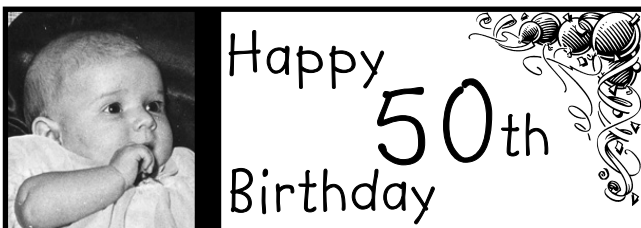
A skills competition will also be held for all divisions at 10 a.m., involving contests such as

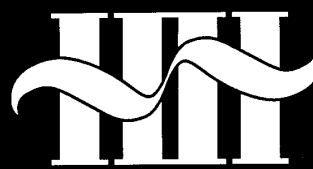
