- respect your dog, accept its character, and train it without excessive domination;
- provide your dog with space, food, vaccinations, and the care required for its well-being and good health;
- devote some time every day to playing with your dog, hugging it, and walking it;
- ensure that your dog doesn't harm its surroundings or the environment; and
- accept the restraints that your dog's presence imposes (on your holidays or furniture, for example).

If you are not ready to fully assume all of these responsibilities, you should forget the idea of getting a dog. A loyal and generous companion, a dog deserves to receive as much from you.
