MUNICIPAL GRANTS

The Corporation of the Town of Caledon invites applications for **Municipal Agricultural and Community Organization Grants**. A formalized grant policy was established in 1994 by the Town outlining the grant eligibility criteria required by organizations.

CATEGORY 1: SUSTAINING

Grants for organizations that are community-based and fairly represent both their own interest and those of the communities in which they serve.

CATEGORY 2: CONTINUING SUPPORT

Grants are to be given only to organizations that maintain a historical and community link between our agricultural, rural and urban communities.

CATEGORY 3: SPECIAL ACTIVITY SUPPORT

Grants are to be given as "seed" money. Funds are allocated to provide start-up funding for a new organization, or a new program within an already existing organization, for activity deemed to be of significant value to the community at large.

Agricultural and community organizations must fall into one of three categories to be eligible for a Town of Caledon Municipal Grant.
