The senior Rebels didn't show signs of not having played a meaningful game for almost three weeks as Leckie was able to sustain the opening drive, rushing behind a sturdy offensive line for the first major score. Central's Trojans rallied behind the passing game of quarterback Matt Stepkowski to take the lead at the intermission, but after some adjustments, Georgetown's defence shut down the Trojans from there, keyed by TD interception returns by Andrew Cannell and Darren Pezzack.

The Jaguars, meanwhile, fell behind 7-0 to Aquinas on a long pass-and-run play in the second quarter, but CtK's Dan Rovere answered back with a
