

A normal heart is a powerful, muscular pump that is slightly larger than a fist. It is part of the body's circulatory system, a network of blood vessels and organs that includes the heart, lungs, arteries, veins and capillaries. The most common cardiac problems are mainly those involving obstruction of the arteries, cardiac arrhythmia, poorly functioning cardiac valves, or a heart attack itself.

Canada's Heart and Stroke Foundation is a volunteer organization whose mission is to improve public health by contributing to research and health awareness. The goal of the organization is to prevent and reduce the disabilities and deaths caused by cardiovascular disease and strokes.

Since 1956, the Foundation has awarded more than \$887 million to support research. Canadian research has helped develop new diagnostic techniques and medical treatments, and has contributed to surgical advances that save lives every year. Programs about nutrition, blood pressure, smoking and physical activity also help reduce the risk of cardiovascular disease and strokes. As well, as the organization that sets the standards for cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) in Canada, the Foundation helps people save lives in emergencies.

The Foundation receives no government funding for its operations. Throughout its existence, it has always relied on the generous support of thousands of Canadians. These public donations continue to save lives every day!
