Delia Martins, a visually impaired hairstylist, has become somewhat of a celebrity following the appearance of a story on her in *The Independent & Free Press* Jan. 5.

Since then Martins has heard from several media outlets interested in the fact that, despite her severe visual impairment resulting from detached retinas, she continues to work as a stylist.

Martins, the owner of Pro Hair Design in the Georgetown Market Place, said the CBC interviewed her Wednesday, CITY TV was there yesterday (Thursday) and CNN was scheduled to do a story with her Friday.

She has also been contacted by the producer at VIP On Air, a radio station in Glasgow, Scotland for blind and partially sighted people interested in interviewing her.

Martins said she can't believe the response her story has generated.

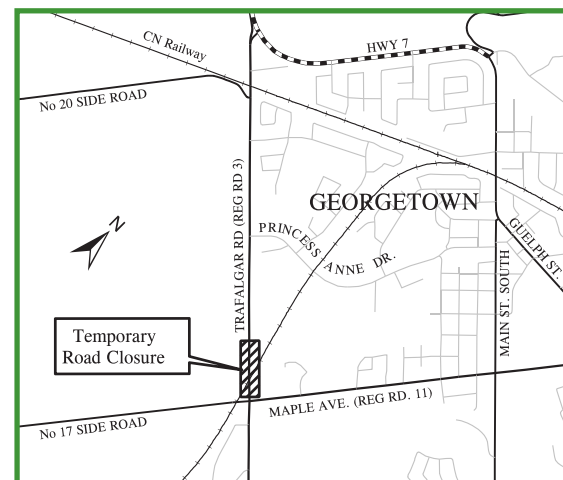
TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE
