

# Halton holiday RIDE stats show sharp increase in drinking drivers

Although fewer impaired driving charges were laid during the 2006 Holiday Ride program compared to the previous year, Halton officers found that more people had been drinking before getting behind the wheel.


During the 2006 RIDE program Halton Police stopped 27,359 vehicles—7,643 fewer than 2005—but found 20 more drivers had been drinking.

"Those 20 drivers had consumed enough alcohol that when they performed a roadside screening device test, they were found to have sufficient alcohol in their systems (50 mg or more) that they could not legally drive and their drivers licences were suspended for 12 hours," said Sgt. Peter Payne.

In total, two impaired driving charges were laid during the RIDE program last year compared to seven the previous year.

Despite the lower number of impaired charges laid police are concerned that more drivers were found to have been drinking.

"The alcohol drink that you consume can

take from a few minutes to an hour to affect your sobriety," said Payne.

"Some might be lulled into thinking they can consume more than they should before getting behind the wheel. The last drink you consume may not begin to affect your judgment until after you begin your drive. It's too late at that point and that is when the problems begin."

Police urge everyone to think before taking a drink and take a taxi, get a ride from a sober friend or use designated drivers if they have been drinking.

The number of people charged with impaired driving last year was actually the lowest of all the Holiday RIDE programs in Halton over the past five years; however, it was also the same year that far fewer vehicles were stopped.
