Born into slavery in Maryland, Harriet Tubman not only ran away to escape slavery, she returned to the south 19 times to lead over 300 other slaves to freedom.

On a barren stage with only a trunkful of costumes, the Harriet Tubman story is retold from her early childhood to elder years. Using Harriet's own words, the story takes the audience through her solo flight from slavery, her involvement with the Underground Railroad, her victorious rescue mission during the civil war and her continued commitment to others in later years.

The Spirit of Harriet Tubman is a powerful show exploring the life of a heroine and tireless worker for social justice that is a must-see for students and teachers alike. The performance is geared towards students' in Grade 6 and up.

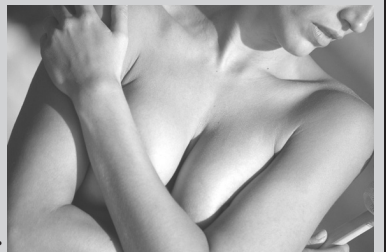

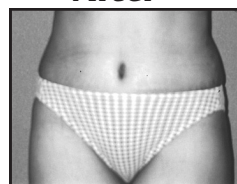

NEW REGULATIONS FOR HANDLING, TRANSPORTING AND DISPOSING OF CATTLE CARCASSES AND TISSUES

The Canadian Food Inspection Agency (CFIA) is enhancing regulations to help eliminate bovine spongiform encephalopathy (BSE), or mad cow disease, from Canada.

Beginning July 12, 2007, there are new requirements for cattle producers; slaughterhouses; feed, pet food and fertilizer manufacturers; waste management facilities and others who handle, transport or dispose of cattle remains.

Everyone involved must be prepared.
