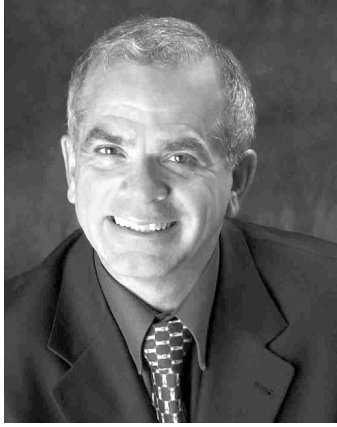

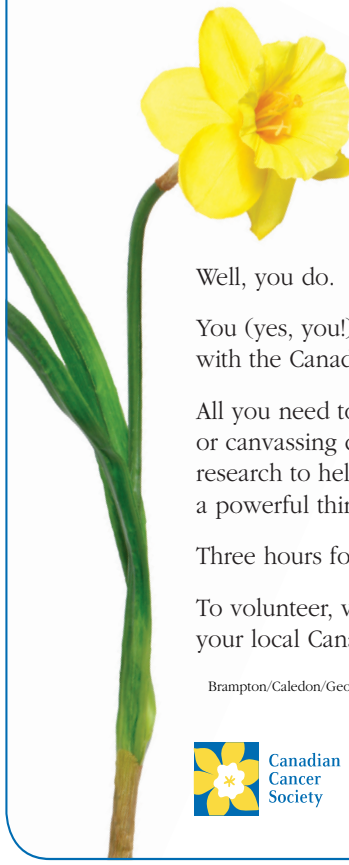
Applications should address the following:
