Concerning Applications to Amend the Town of Halton Hills Zoning By-law For land located at 89 Mill Street Part of Lots 26 and 27, Block 5 Registered Plan 31 Town of Halton Hills (Acton)

Town of Halton Hills Files D14ZBA07.002 (H.E.L.P. Safety Services, 89 Mill Street)

The General Committee for the Town of Halton Hills will conduct a Public Meeting to examine and discuss a proposed amendment application to the Town of Halton Hills Zoning By-law 1358, as amended. The proposed amendment applies to the property municipally known as 89 Mill Street, Town of Halton Hills (Acton).

Below is a map showing the location of the subject property to which the proposed Zoning By-law Amendment would apply. There is currently a residential dwelling on the site.

The purpose and effect of the proposed amendment application are to allow the existing building to be used as a business office. The subject lands are zoned "Commercial - General (Holding)" (C-1 (H)) by Zoning By-law 1358. The applicant is requesting to change the zoning for the subject property to a site-specific "General Commercial -Special" (C1-1) Zone, to permit the conversion to a business office.

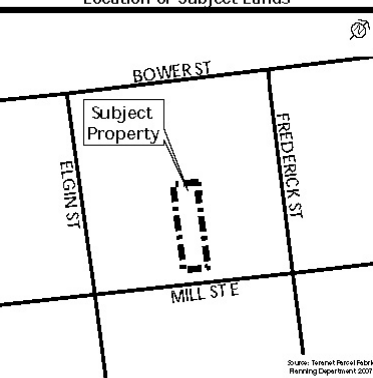
If you wish to be notified of the decision of the Town of Halton Hills in respect of this proposed Zoning By-law Amendment, you must make a written request to the Town of Halton Hills at 1 Halton Hills Drive, Halton Hills, Ontario L7G 5G2.

If a person or public body that files a notice of appeal of a decision of the Town of Halton Hills in respect of the proposed Zoning By-law Amendment does not make oral submissions at a public meeting or make written submissions to the Town of Halton Hills before the proposed Zoning By-law Amendment is adopted, the Ontario Municipal Board may dismiss all or part of the appeal.

NOTE: Any written comment/objection submitted to the Town of Halton Hills regarding this application(s) which is being processed under the Planning Act 1990, may be made public as part of the application process.

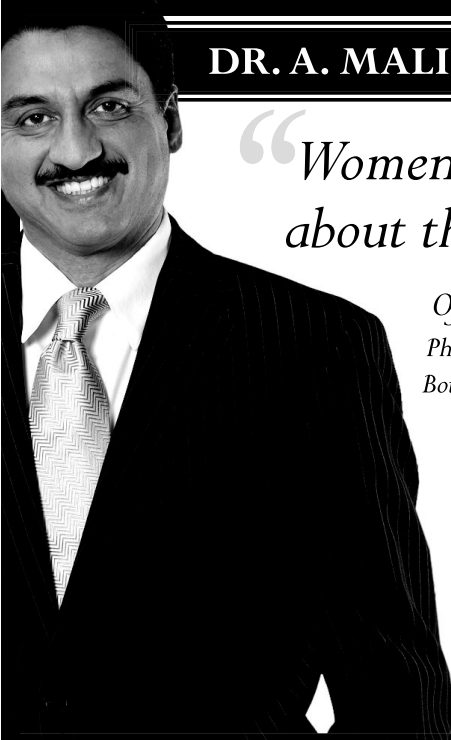
