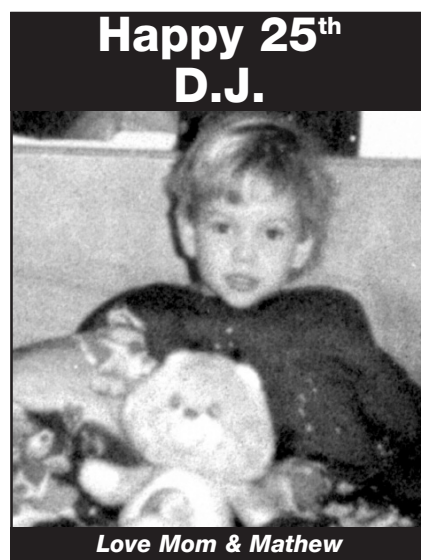


Just for girls
