At Charles St. the procession will turn right and proceed along Charles St. past Princess Anne Drive to James St., then right on James St. to the "pavilion" at Remembrance Park. Reception to follow at Branch 120. *Members of the public may join the procession at any point.

All Veterans Are Invited.


On this day, the residents of Halton Hills along with 1100 area school children will gather in order to pay tribute to your sacrifices & achievements.
