Kelsey Grant is active in her church, school and community. Her consistently kind, caring and unselfish attitude sets an excellent example.



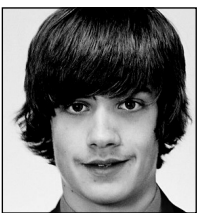
Chantal Baran
