Rebel golfers move on to OFSAA

Two Georgetown Rebels qualified for the 36-hole OFSAA 2007 Festival early next week in Burlington thanks to their rounds at Monday's Golden Horseshoe Athletic Conference championship at the Beverly Golf & Country Club in Copetown.

Luke Ovenden tied for first with J.J. Regan of Notre Dame with a one-over-par 71, while GDHS's Adam Salisbury was among three golfers at six-over 76 to earn berths at OFSAA, to be held on Monday and Tuesday at the Hidden Lake Golf Club.




