are provided by qualified individuals at an affordable cost. Please call Kim, 905-873-6502.

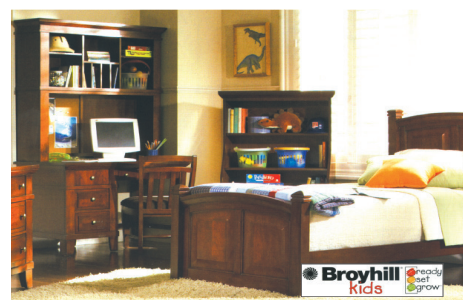
## Volunteers wanted for seniors programs

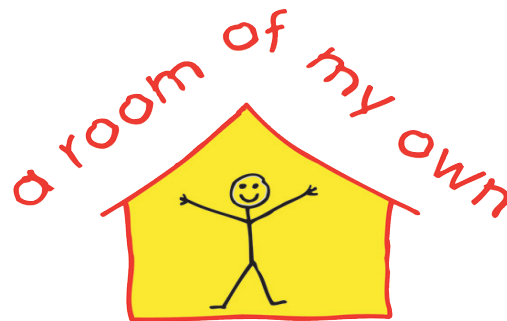
