



Dozens of activities have been planned for the course of

the three-day event, which runs Friday to Sunday.

On Friday the registration/sign in will run from 5-7 p.m. at the Mold-Masters SportsPlex where registrants can pick up registration packages, which will include wristbands, tickets, and the Homecoming guide.

From 7-9 p.m. Friday there will be a Meet & Mingle (wine and cheese party), at the SportsPlex.

Among the highlights on Saturday, Georgetown District High School will host a 120th reunion from 10 a.m.-3 p.m.

and a reunion dance will be held at the Mold-Masters SportsPlex Saturday night featuring six local bands—including a reunion of Station House.

On Sunday Homecoming wraps up with a March of Remembrance/Closing Ceremony along Main Street beginning at 3 p.m.
