

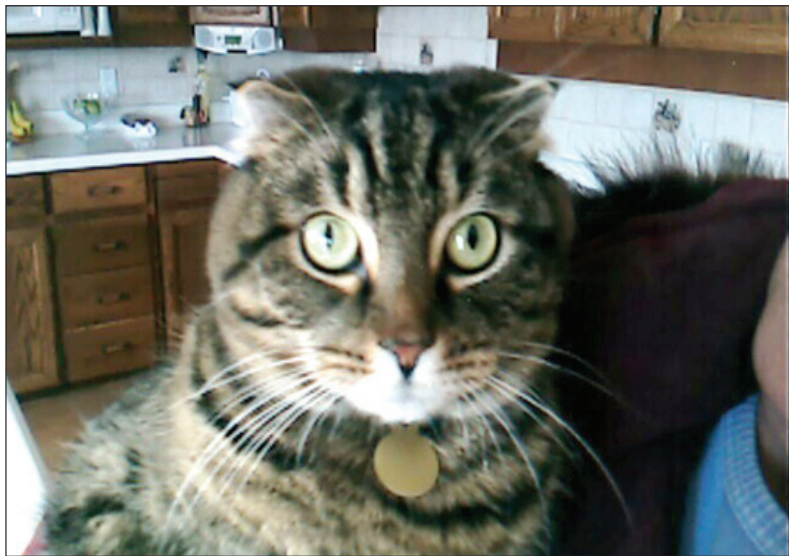


## A Royal celebration
