School calendar set for 2007-08

The Ministry of Education recently approved the Halton District School Board's school year calendar for 2007-2008.

These dates were sent home with students and are also posted on the board's website at www.hdsb.ca

The first day of school for the 2007-2008 school year will be Tuesday, September 4, 2007. Junior and Senior Kindergarten school visits and staggered entry will take place during the first two weeks of school.

Professional activity days have been scheduled for both elementary and secondary schools on October 5, November 2, December 7, February

1, April 25, and June 27.

The Christmas break will run from December 24, 2007 to January 4, 2008, inclusive, with students returning to class on Monday, January 7, 2008.

The March Break for the 2007-2008 school year will be held from March 10-14, 2008 (inclusive). The Friday prior to the March Break (March 7) is scheduled as a board designated holiday and schools will be closed.

High school examinations for the first semester will be scheduled from January 24 to January 30, 2008. Second semester exams will be slated from June 19 to June 25, 2008.

Police need auxiliary officers

Halton Regional Police Service is currently seeking applications for volunteer auxiliary police officers.

The officers are expected to begin training next January.

Auxiliary officers receive more than 100 hours of training including legal training in powers of arrest, ethics, traffic direction and use of force.

Auxiliary members are commonly utilized to augment the activities of police officers at annual events such as fall fairs, Christmas parades, Burlington Sound of Music Festival and Oakville Waterfront Festival.

They also often accompany police officers on general patrol duties.

The first phase of the selection process is a general aptitude test planned for the second and third weeks of September.

Applicants will receive a written invitation outlining their testing date, time and location.

Those who have recently submitted an application need not re-apply.

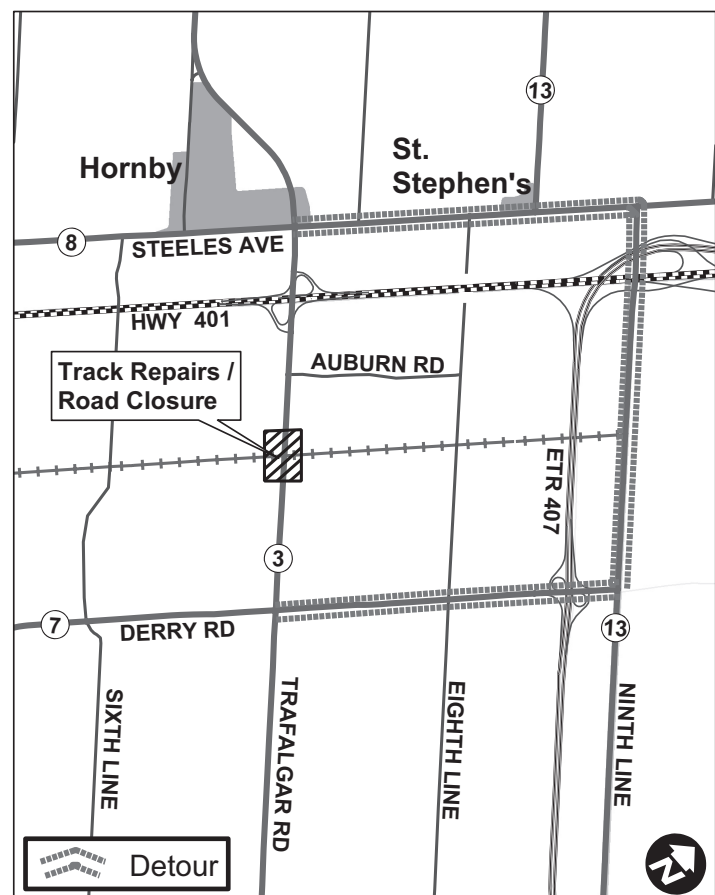
ROAD CLOSURE

TRAFALGAR ROAD (REGIONAL ROAD 3) CPR MAINTENANCE WORK TOWN OF MILTON

Notice is hereby given in accordance with the provisions of Regional Municipality of Halton - By-Law No. 162-88 - regarding the following temporary road closure for scheduled track maintenance purposes by CP Railway.

Trafalgar Road (Regional Road 3) will be closed between Auburn Road and Derry Road (Regional Road 7) within the Town of Milton. **Maintenance to commence on Monday, August 13 at 8:30 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. on Wednesday, August 15, 2007 to facilitate maintenance repair work by CP Railway.** Temporary road closure signage will be posted on Trafalgar Road, prior to the road closure.
