Police blotter

Memorial garden vandalized

Halton Police are asking for assistance from the public in finding the culprit(s) responsible for ripping out several plants and stealing a dedication plaque at the Max MacSween Memorial Gardens in Acton early Tuesday.

Police report the incident occurred sometime between midnight and 8 a.m. in the gardens located in Rotary Park.

The missing dedication plaque inscribed with "This garden is dedicated in memory of Max MacSween. An inspiration to us all. Acton Horticultural Society— 2007" was attached to a large rock in the garden.

Police searched the park but did not find the plaque.

The damage and value of the stolen plaque is estimated at \$700.

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A 1992 Ford F450 with a dump box on the back was stolen from North Halton Golf and Country Club sometime between Sunday and Tuesday. The truck was parked beside a maintenance barn.

The \$6,000 truck was later recovered by Ontario Provincial Police on a property in Dufferin County.

At press time no charges had been laid in connection with the theft.

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Approximately \$700 damage was caused to a fence at the front of a Mill St. Georgetown home late Monday or early Tuesday. It had been pushed over and large tire tracks were found on the lawn by the fence.

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A 14-foot aluminum boat, valued at about \$2,000, was taken from the rear of a Regional Rd. 25 Acton property sometime Monday or Tuesday.

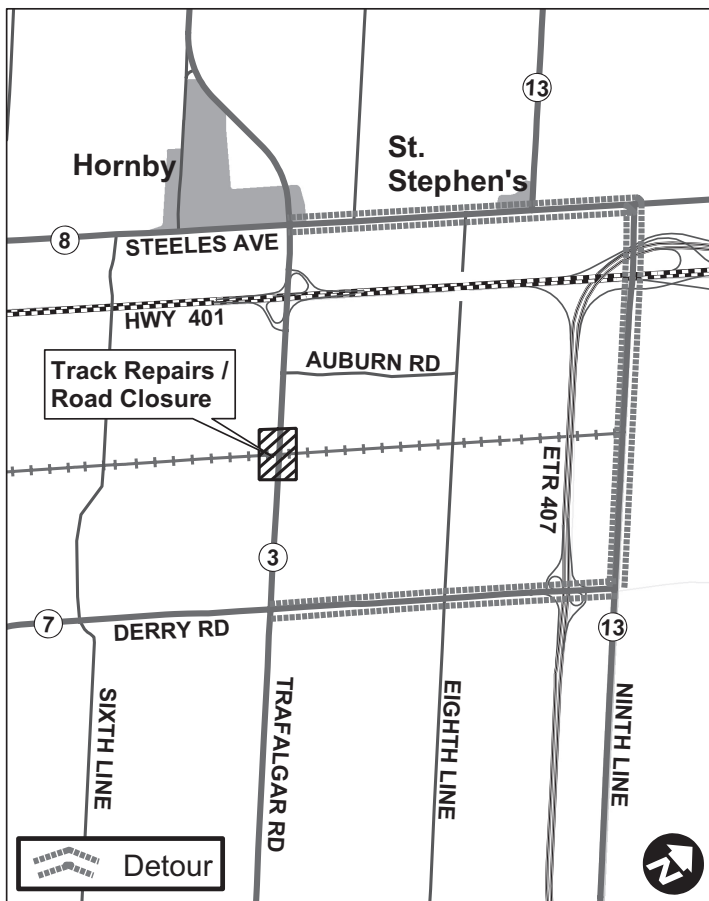

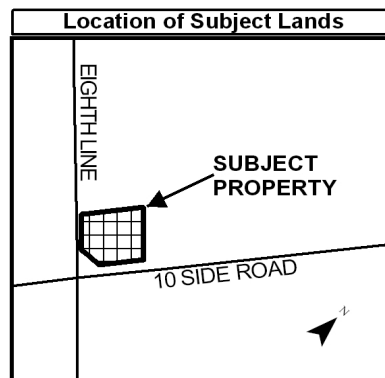
NOTICE OF A PUBLIC MEETING

Concerning Application to Amend the Town of Halton Hills Zoning By-law
For lands located on the northeast corner of 10 Side Road and 8th Line
Part of Lot 11, Concession 9, being parts 1 & 2 on Plan 20R-8851 Municipally known as "0" 10 Side Road Town of Halton Hills (Georgetown)

Town of Halton Hills File D14ZBA07.005
South Georgetown Fire Headquarters Station 2

General Committee for the Town of Halton Hills will conduct a Public Meeting to examine and discuss the proposed amendment application to the Town of Halton Hills Zoning By-law 74-51, as amended. The proposed amendment applies to the property known as "0" 10 Side Road, Town of Halton Hills (Georgetown). The Town owned vacant subject property is located at the northeast corner of 10 Side Road and 8th Line.

Below is a map showing the location of the subject property to which the proposed Zoning By-law amendment would apply.



The purpose and effect of the proposed amendment application is to permit the development of the new Georgetown South Fire Headquarters Station 2 on the subject site. The property is currently designated Residential Area - Medium Density by the Town of Halton Hills Official Plan (OPA 95). This designation permits institutional uses such as fire and police stations.

The subject lands are zoned Rural (RU) Zone by Zoning By-law 74-51, as amended. The Town of Halton Hills is proposing to change the zoning for the subject property to a site-specific Rural (RU) Zone to facilitate the development of a fire station.

If you wish to be notified of the decision of the Town of Halton Hills in respect of this proposed Zoning By-law Amendment, you must make a written request to the Town of Halton Hills - PLANNING & DEVELOPMENT DEPARTMENT at 1 Halton Hills Drive, Halton Hills, Ontario L7G 5G2.

If a person or public body does not make oral submissions at a public meeting or make written submissions to the Town of Halton Hills before the by-law is passed, the person or public body is not entitled to appeal the decision of Council of the Town of Halton Hills to the Ontario Municipal Board.

If a person or public body does not make oral submissions at a public meeting, or make written submissions to the Town of Halton Hills before the by-law is passed, the person or public body may not be added as a party to the hearing of an appeal before the Ontario Municipal Board unless, in the opinion of the Board, there are reasonable grounds to do so.

NOTE: Any written comments/objections submitted to the Town of Halton Hills regarding this Application(s) which is being processed under the Planning Act 1990, may be made public as part of the application process.
