

Police seek public's help in apprehending park vandals

Halton Regional Police are looking to the public to help identify the vandal(s) responsible for desecrating a memorial garden in Acton.



Sometime between midnight and 8 a.m. on August 8, vandals removed a plaque valued at \$700 from the memorial garden at Rotary Park, 24 Elizabeth Dr.

The plaque, dedicated in the memory of Max MacSween, is bronze and approximately 11" X 14" in size. Several large plants from the garden were also pulled out and scattered throughout the park. Total damage was valued at \$300.

If you have any information that leads to an arrest in this or any other matter, you



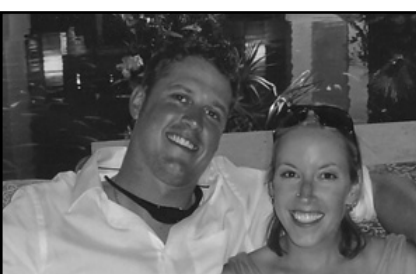
