

# Hill sharp in return

After a three-month stint on the disabled list, Shawn Hill of Georgetown has returned to the Washington Nationals and looked just as impressive in two recent starts as he did before his latest injury.

The 26-year-old righthander threw six shutout innings against the Philadelphia Phillies last week before hitting his 80-pitch limit, striking out a career-high seven batters and allowing only a bloop single. The game was scoreless when Hill left and the Phillies went on to pull out a late 3-2 victory.

This past Sunday, Hill had another quality start at home versus the first-place New York Mets, lasting seven innings before again not getting a decision. The sinkerball specialist left with the score tied at two and the Mets touched up the relief help for six unanswered runs in the last two innings.

Hill is 3-3 with a team-leading 2.41 earned run average for the vastly improved Nationals, who will move into a new stadium next season. His left shoulder was injured in April while running the bases and began to have a flare-up of soreness in his reconstructed throwing elbow, putting him on the disabled list May 11.

But the former shortstop pronounced himself pain-free after his first start back— save for some awkward-looking at-bats.

Hill will face fellow Canadian starter Jeff Francis tonight (Friday) when the Nats visit the Colorado Rockies.

If Washington's pitching rotation continues as is, it appears as though Hill will miss the opportunity to take on home-run king Barry Bonds when the San Francisco Giants visit RFK Stadium for a three-game series on the Labour Day weekend.
