Freshman Albrecht wins tryout

Christ the King High School grad Andrew Albrecht made a good first impression as a freshman at the University of Massachusetts Lowell by winning an open tryout for the Riverhawk men's varsity golf team last week.

The Georgetown resident and North Halton Golf & Country Club member was five shots back of the leader heading into the second and final round of the tryout, then fired a 70 to win by one stroke out of a field of 21 players who were vying for seven spots on the 2007-08 UML golf roster.

Albrecht, a management major, was set to make his NCAA debut today (Friday) at a tournament in Middletown, Delaware.

Although most of the major tournaments on the Golf Association of Ontario's 2007 schedule

have been played, some Halton Hills' residents continued to chalk up top-10 results in recent team events.

A foursome from the North Halton Golf & Country Club finished as runners-up at Tuesday's George S. Lyon Championship held at the Rattlesnake Point Golf Club in Milton, three shots back of the winners from the National Golf Club of Canada.

Mike Kotsos, Brad Spears, David Kotsos and Bob Hebert teamed up to shoot six over par through 18 holes of stroke play with rounds of 72-71-77-74 and earned silver medals.

On Labour Day, Eagle Ridge Golf Club members M.J. Cassibo and Dan Beverley of Campbellville combined to shoot a four-under-par 68 to win by two strokes at the GAO's Mixed Championship at Wooden Sticks in Uxbridge.

Georgetown's Mary Ann Lapointe and Aron Burch of Hamilton placed in a tie for sixth in the low gross category at +3, while North Halton members Terry Madill and Lori Hofing carded a 78, tied for 16th. Diane and Ted Cutting of Georgetown were tied for fifth in the senior net division at -4.

Hawks sixth

After finishing first in their preliminary pool with just six runs allowed in four games, the Halton Hills Hawks ended up placing sixth in the midget II girls' division at the Eastern Canadian Softball Championships in Alberton, P.E.I.

The Hawks capped a successful season in which they placed second in Ontario to eventual ECSC champion Palmerston and qualified for the World Series of Fastpitch in Florida earlier in the summer.

Host Prince County eliminated Halton Hills from the Eastern Canadians with a 5-4 win, scoring in the bottom of the final inning.
